TRAINING

All orthopaedic training was done at Pretoria Academic Hospital. Training started in 1992. I was medical officer for two and a half years at the Department of Orthopaedics, Pretoria. I was appointed as clinical assistant for five years at the Department of Orthopaedics, Pretoria.

EXPERIENCE

Rotated through all the disciplines in Orthopaedics during training. Part of the Microsurgery Unit since 1996. Extensive trauma experience. Has done trauma calls from 1995 to 2000 as a medical officer and registrar, doing the whole range of orthopaedic trauma. Part of the Microsurgery Unit doing mostly peripheral nerve surgery. I have personally done sixty brachial plexus exposure and cable graftings. The Brachial plexus clinic, which I ran until 2012, had two hundred and fifty patients circulating through it. Since 2000 I am in private practice, doing mainly large joint arthroscopy, arthroplasty and trauma. Arthroplasty operations - approximately four to six per week. Shoulder arthroscopies – eight to ten per week. Private orthopaedic surgery – two theatre lists per week. I have done ATLS. Current weekly workload includes two theatre lists in private practice, doing arthroscopies of large joints and arthroplasty, as well as general orthopaedic surgery. On call as consultant for spinal trauma at the Pretoria Academic Hospital for twelve days a month until 2012.
